1 Who is responsible for the data processing?

2 For which purposes and on which legal bases are your data processed? Where does Klöckner & Co SE obtain your data?

Klöckner & Co SE processes your personal data in compliance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG), the German Stock Corporation Act (AktG), and all other relevant legal provisions.

Klöckner & Co SE processes your data to safeguard legitimate interests pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR in order to collect statistical information on the number of participants. The primary objective is to distinguish internal from external participants and thus to be able to create more precise evaluations. In addition, you have the option to ask questions. If you wish to do so, we require your data in order to address you by name.

Our legitimate interests lie in pursuing the purposes described above. Your data are not used for marketing purposes.



3 To which categories of recipients may your data be disclosed?

External service providers: Klöckner & Co SE uses the services of external providers for hosting the telephone conference and the webcast, as well as IT infrastructure providers for internal collaboration (emails, creation of documents, etc.).

4 How long will your data be stored?

The retention period for the personal data collected is generally up to 30 days. As a rule, your personal data are deleted or anonymised as soon as they are no longer required for the purposes stated further above.

5 What rights do you have?

As a data subject, you may at any time contact our Data Protection Officer informally in order to exercise your rights under the GDPR. These rights are as follows:

- the right to obtain information about the data processing as well as a copy of the processed data (right of access, Article 15 GDPR),
- the right to request the rectification of inaccurate data or the completion of incomplete data (right to rectification, Article 16 GDPR),
- the right to request the erasure of personal data and, if the personal data have been made public, to request that other controllers be informed of the request for erasure (right to erasure, Article 17 GDPR),
- the right to request the restriction of processing (right to restriction of processing, Article 18 GDPR),
- the right to receive the personal data concerning you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to request the transmission of those data to another controller (right to data portability, Article 20 GDPR),
- **the right to object: where your data are processed to safeguard legitimate interests, you may object to such processing at any time using the contact details provided, provided that reasons arise from your particular situation which conflict with this data processing. The processing will then be discontinued**



unless the company can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject, or unless the processing serves the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims (right to object, Article 21 GDPR),

- the right to withdraw consent at any time in order to prevent data processing based on your consent. The withdrawal does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal (right of withdrawal, Article 7 GDPR),
- the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the GDPR (right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, Article 77 GDPR). The right to lodge a complaint may in particular be exercised with a supervisory authority at your habitual place of residence or at the registered office of Klöckner & Co SE. The competent data protection supervisory authority for Klöckner & Co SE is the State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information of North Rhine-Westphalia, P.O. Box 20 04 44, 40102 Düsseldorf.
